- 1. I will send this signed contract to the Extension Office postmarked or emailed on or before December 1.
- 2. I will maintain my membership with my local chapter as a member in good standing according to said chapter, Montana and National Constitution and Bylaws.
- 3. I will have my animal(s) in possession on or before December 1. I understand two photos of the animal(s) are required. One photo will be of the animal's head with the ear tag showing. The other photo needs be a complete side view of the animal with the ear tag visible and readable. [Good quality digital photographs along with the market animal information form (available in FairEntry) will be submitted electronically and are due on or before December 15. Any photographs not meeting the above criteria will be requested to be resubmitted.]
- 4. I will hold the highest degree available to me.
- 5. I will keep all required FFA records and submit my record sheets as required:
 - A. All livestock records will be presented at interview judging.
 - B. All completed books and livestock records will be presented to leaders or advisors during my chapter's September meeting.
 - C. One third of each replacement bred sale heifer species project will be randomly selected for audit between September 1 and October 1 by the Extension office. My books and records must be completed by October 1.
- 6. I understand I will need to take the Market Animal Quality Assurance training every two years to remain certified.
- 7. I understand the livestock sale expense deductions, as approved by the Livestock Council, will be deducted from my sale check.
- 8. During the fair, I will complete and hang my stall poster in its respective place by the end of Thursday, compete in the appropriate showmanship contest and work at least one shift in the 4-H Chuckwagon.
- 10. I will help set-up prior to the fair and clean the livestock barn after the livestock sale. (This includes removing wood chips and debris from the barn, taking down and putting away panels, and working with the superintendent). I will check in and check out with barn superintendents or make prior arrangements. If terms are not met, a \$200 fee will be withheld from my livestock sale check.

I understand failure to complete the above items will result in being placed on probation for the following year. An action plan will be developed in a meeting including a minimum of, my parent, Extension staff, livestock council member, and an FFA advisor.
