

Gallatin County 4-H Youth Representative Application

Youth Representatives are a great asset to 4-H Committees and bring the perspective of an active 4-H member. A youth representative must be 14 or older on October 1 of the 4-H year. Each Committee allows 2 4-H youth to be voting members of the committee. Below is a description of each committee, term length, and meeting information so you can best match a committee to your 4-H interests.

Gallatin County 4-H/FFA Market Livestock Committee

Mission: The Purpose of this committee shall be to: To develop and promote all livestock projects (Beef, Sheep, Swine, Goat, Rabbit, and Poultry) in 4-H and FFA on a county-wide basis. Provide members the educational experience and support to responsibly raise, care for, and sell their 4-H/FFA market animal. To organize & facilitate the Gallatin County 4-H/FFA Market Sale. To create and enforce the Fair Book Rules specific to all livestock species. To work together as a committee to set and enforce the standard for all livestock projects (Beef, Sheep, Swine, Goat, Rabbit, and Poultry).

Term: 1 year

Meetings: Vary from month to month

Note: *FFA students can apply to be a youth representative on this committee.

Unlimited Leader's Council (ULC)

Mission: The mission of the Gallatin 4-H Unlimited Leaders Council is to teach life skills by providing positive, handson, and educational opportunities for and with youth, through the recruitment, training, and development of caring 4-H volunteers, in the hope of creating healthy, proactive future leaders in a global world.

Term: 1 year

Meetings: 1st Tuesday of each month, skip August

Gallatin 4-H Foundation

Mission: The mission of the Gallatin 4-H Foundation is to aid and promote, by financial assistance and support, all types of 4-H programs and other Extension youth programs.

Term: 1 year

Meetings: 4th Thursday of every other month, skip July.
