After lengthy conversation, **Motion to STRIKE OUT #1 highlighted sentence. Kodi Peterson, 2nd Dominique Preputin. PASSED.**

Article 3, #3 & Article 4. Discussion on changing it to 2/3 quorum to vote and change it to 2 votes per club. Or make a simple 1 vote per club, but to be able to move business forward, we need clubs to show up. We need leaders to show up, when they don't like something that has been voted to change they would have been there.

All other highlighted items were in approval as written or as needed.
