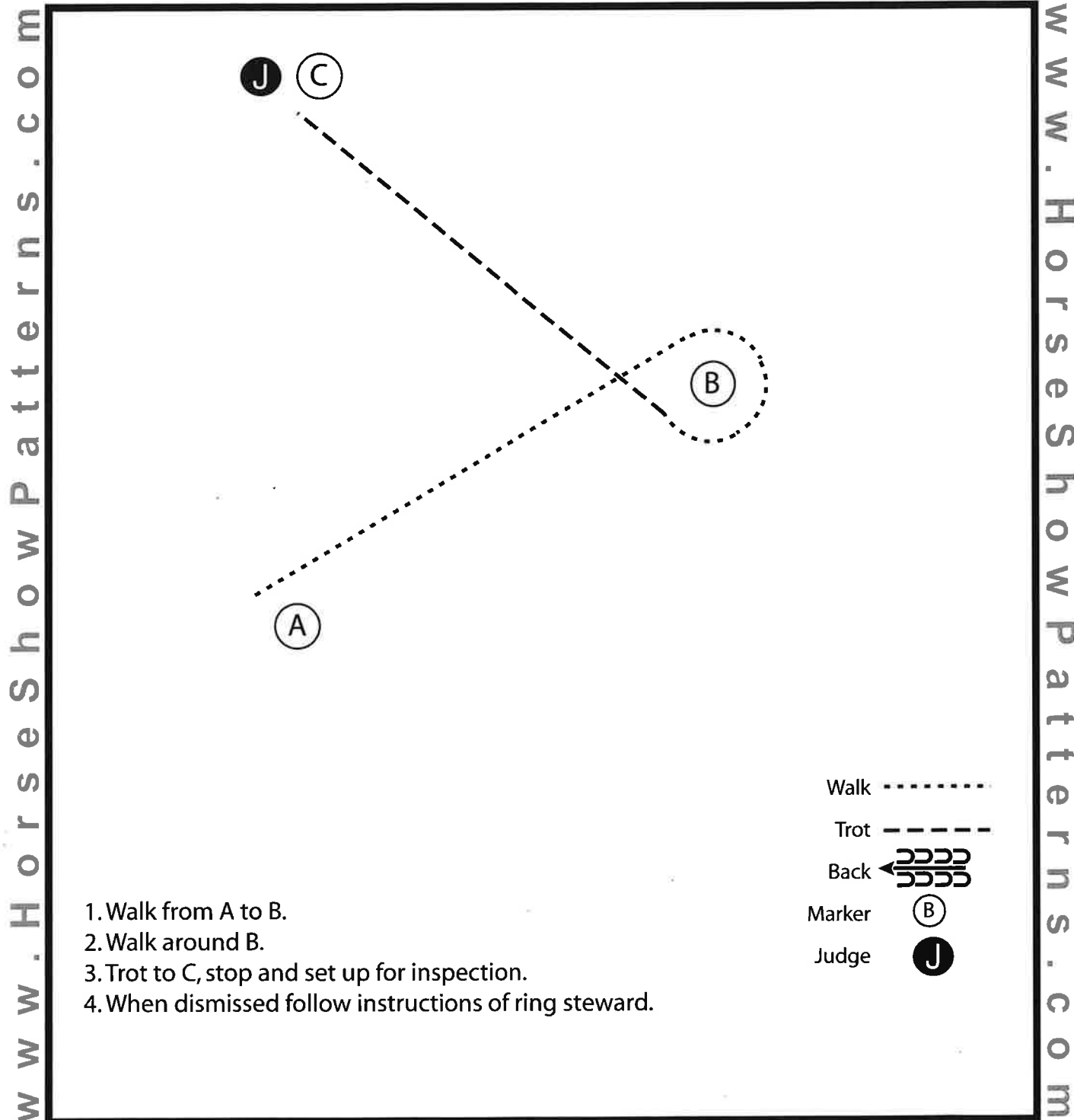

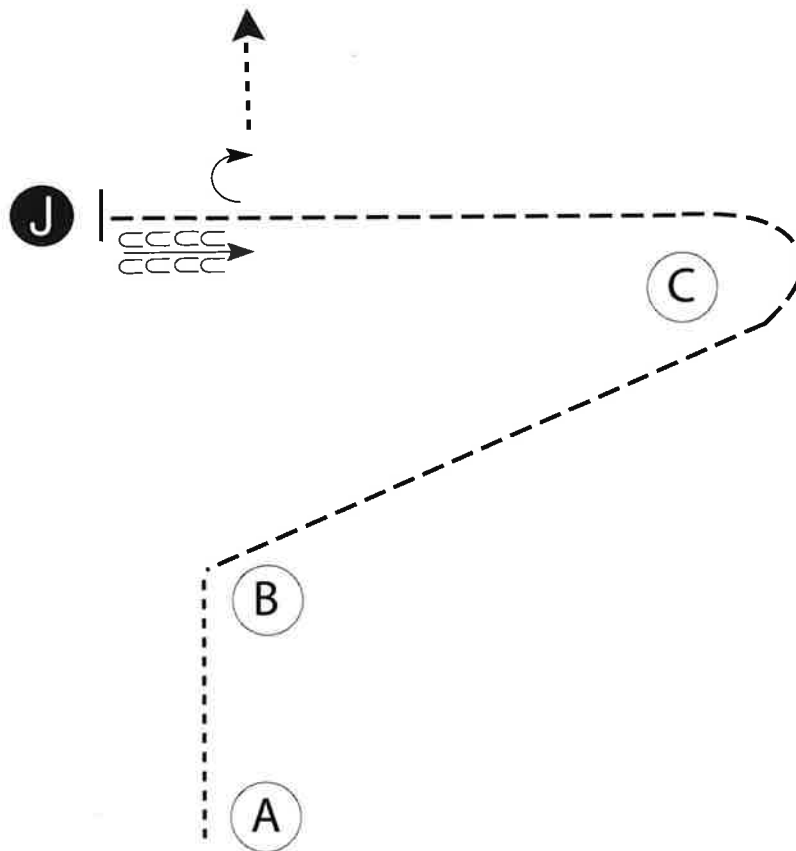

4. When dismissed, back approximately one horse length.
5. Perform a 90 degree turn and walk away from judge.

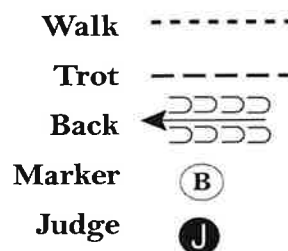
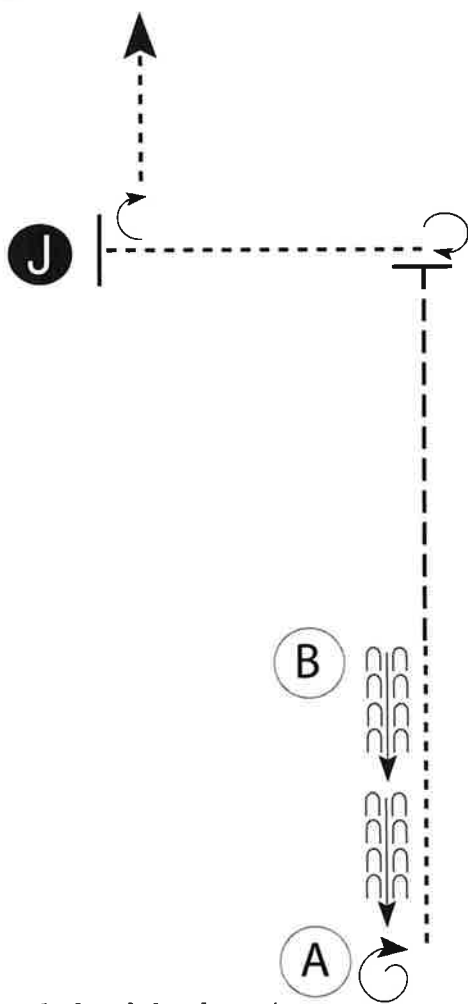

Be ready at B.

1. When acknowledged, back to A.
2. Perform a 360 degree turn.
3. Walk to B.
4. Trot until even with judge and stop.
5. Perform a 270 degree turn.
6. Walk to judge, stop and set up for inspection.
7. When dismissed, perform a 90 degree turn.
8. Walk straight away from judge.

Follow the instructions of your ring steward.

2. Extend the jog at B and circle to the right at the extended jog.
3. Lope on the left lead to C.
4. Change leads between C and D.
5. Lope on the right lead to E.
6. Stop at E and back one horse length.

Retire to the rail or line up at a jog.

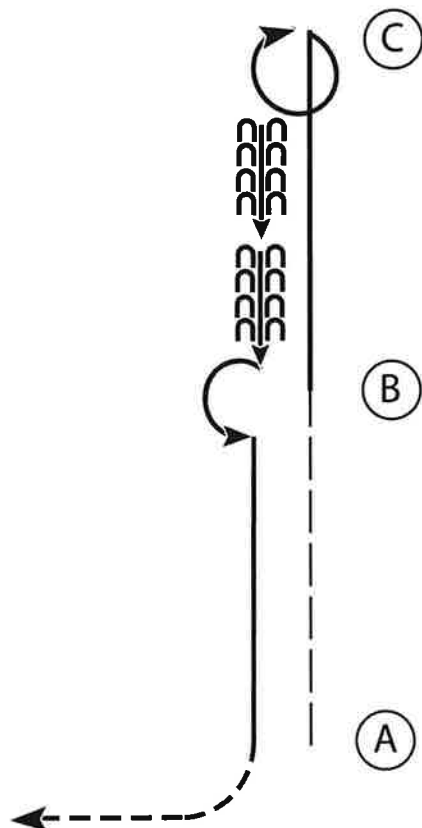

4. Back to B.
5. Stop and perform a 180 degree spin to the left on the hindquarters.
6. Lope right lead to A.
7. At A jog. Jog to the line-up.

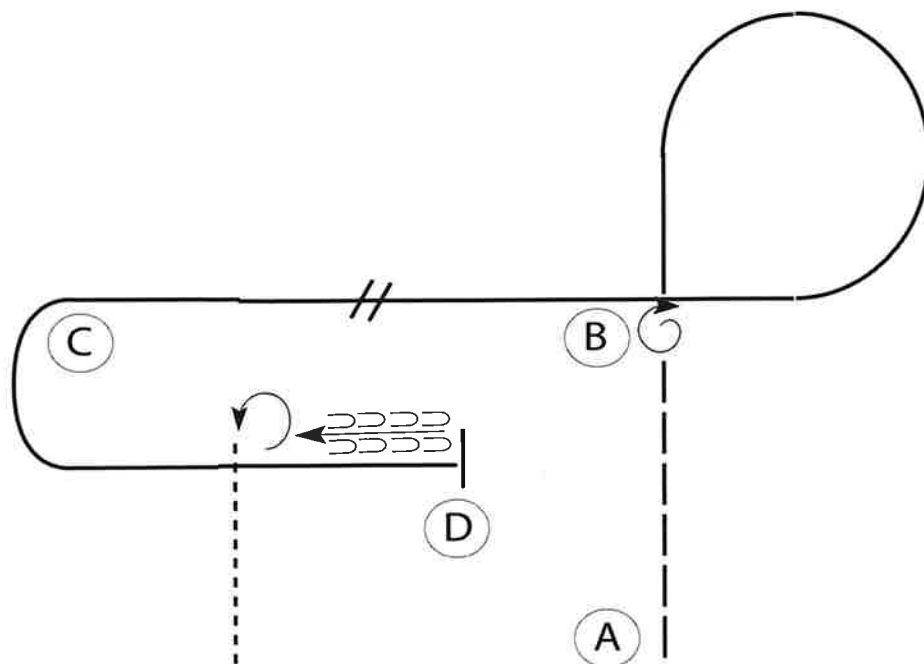

Be ready at A.

1. Extend the jog from A to B.
2. Stop at B and complete 2 360 degree spins to the right.
3. Lope a large fast circle to the right.
4. At B, slow to a lope.
5. Halfway between B and C, change leads.
6. Lope on the left lead to D.
7. Stop at D and back approximately one horse length.
8. Spin 3/4 turn to the left and walk off.

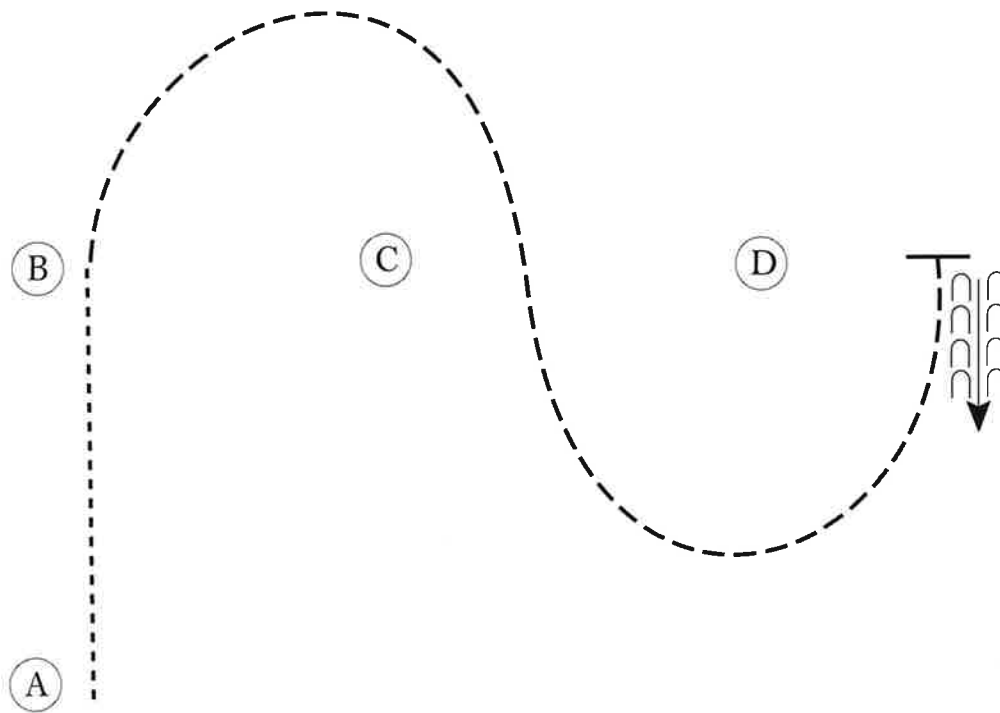

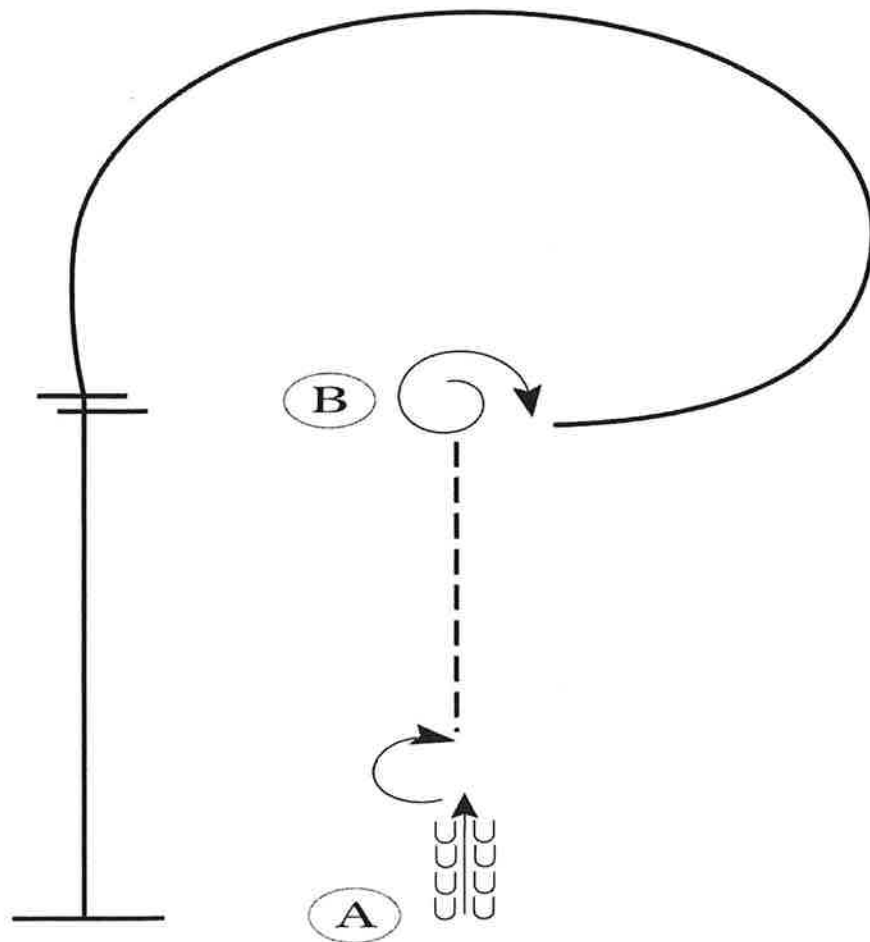

COLT TO MATURITY 5-YEAR OLD / GREEN HORSE LEVEL 4

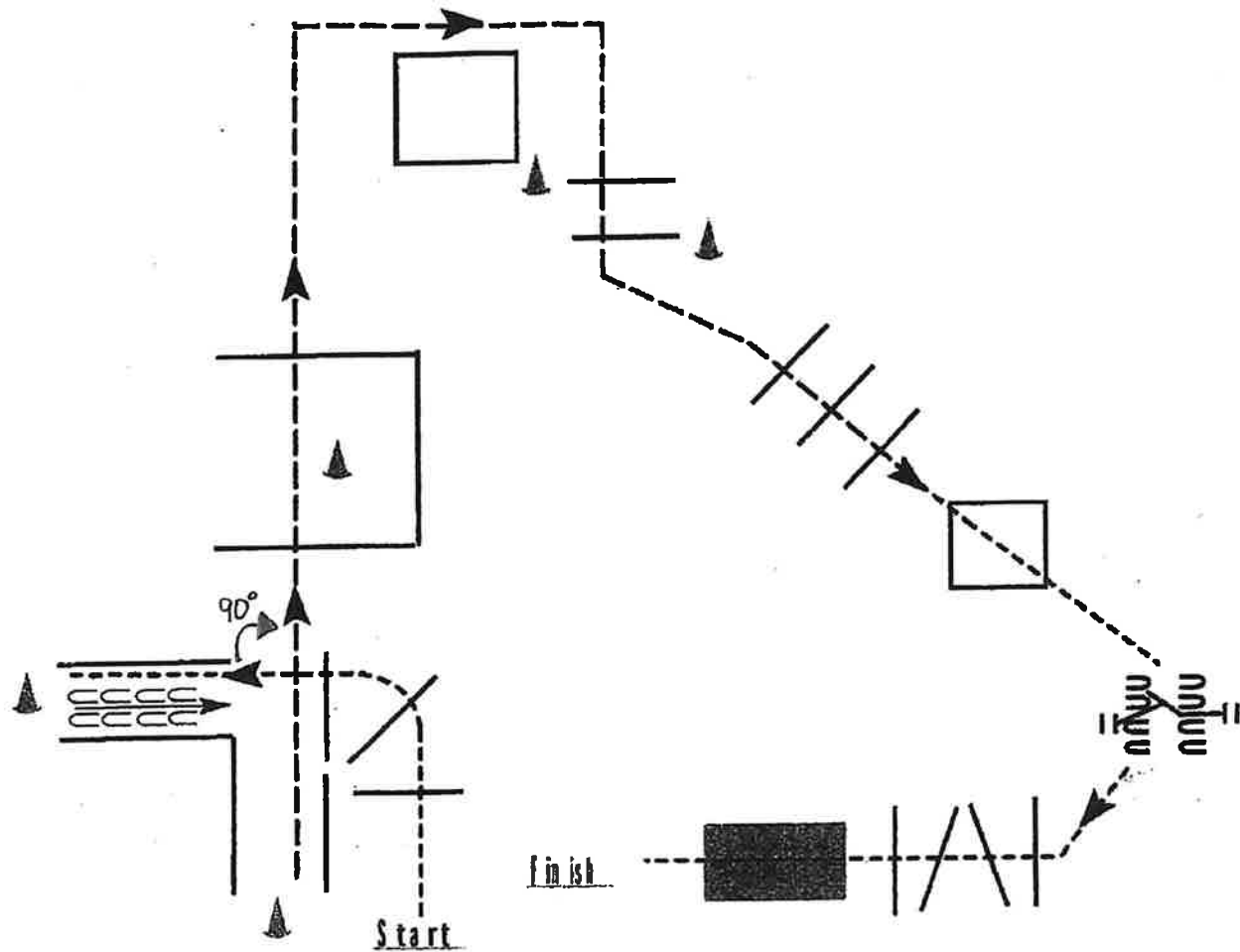


Be ready at A

1. Back approximately one horse length.
2. Turn 180 degrees to the right.
3. Jog to B.
4. Stop at B and turn 1 ¼ turn to the right.
5. Lope on the left lead around B.
6. Perform a simple or flying lead change to B.
7. Lope on the right lead to A.
8. Stop at A. Walk forward and follow the instructions on your ring steward.

WALK TROT & JUNIOR TRAIL AND COLT TRAIL



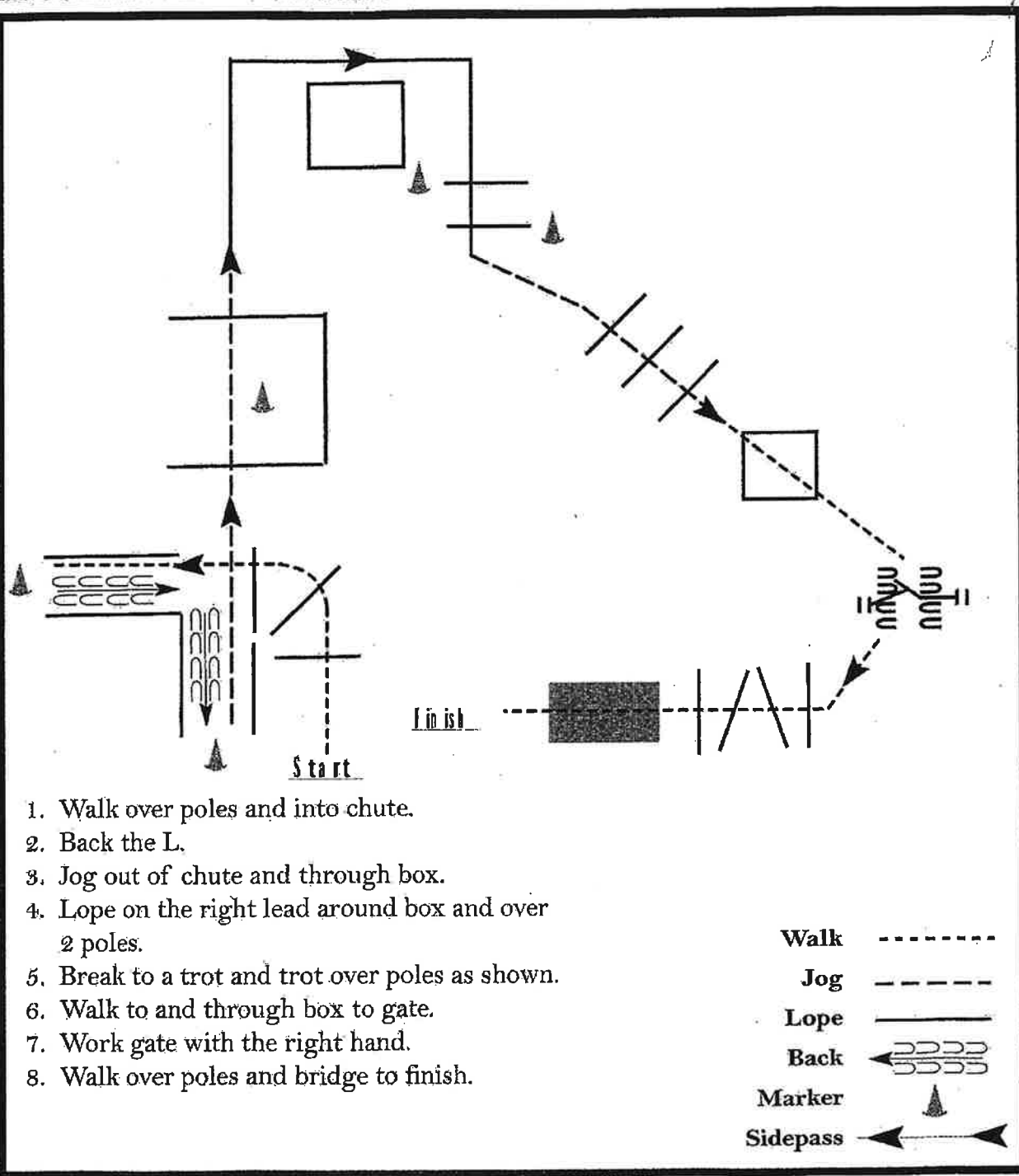
1. Walk over poles and into chute.
2. Back out of chute.
3. Turn 90 degrees to right and trot through box.
4. Trot around box and over 2 poles.
5. Continue to trot over poles as shown
6. Walk through box and through OPEN gate.
7. Walk over poles and bridge to finish.

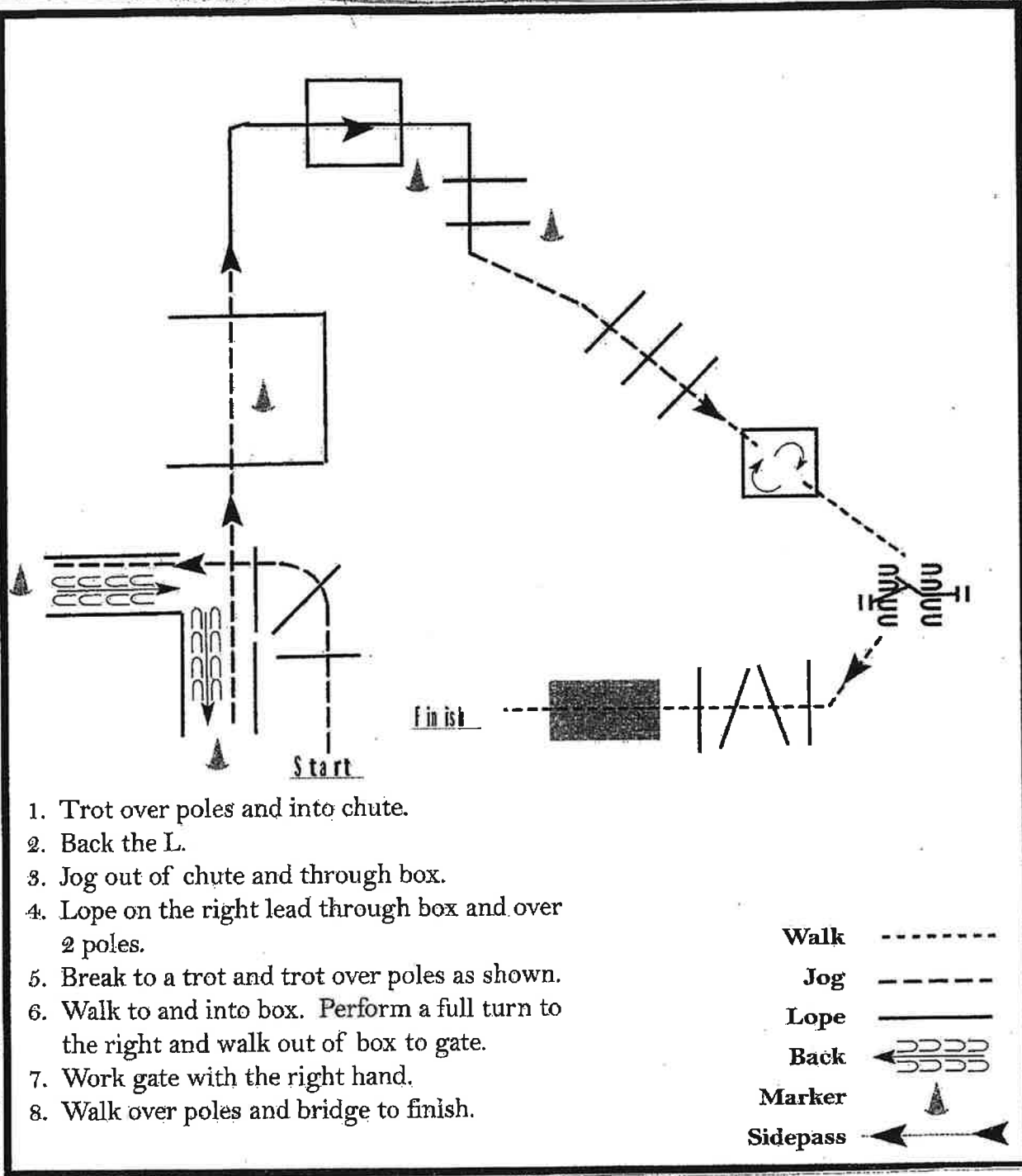

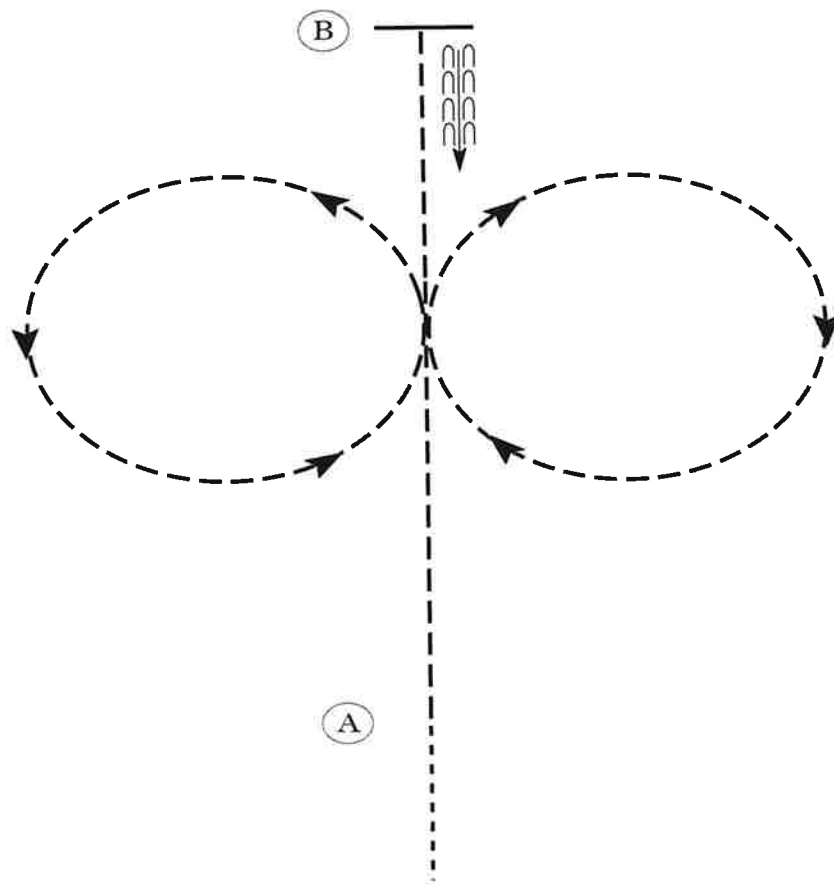


1. Trot over poles and into chute.
2. Back the L.
3. Jog out of chute and through box.
4. Lope on the right lead through box and over 2 poles.
5. Break to a trot and trot over poles as shown.
6. Walk to and into box. Perform a full turn to the right and walk out of box to gate.
7. Work gate with the right hand.
8. Walk over poles and bridge to finish.

3. When halfway to B trot circle to the right followed by a trot circle to the left.
4. Continue the trot to B.
5. At B stop and back approximately one horse length.

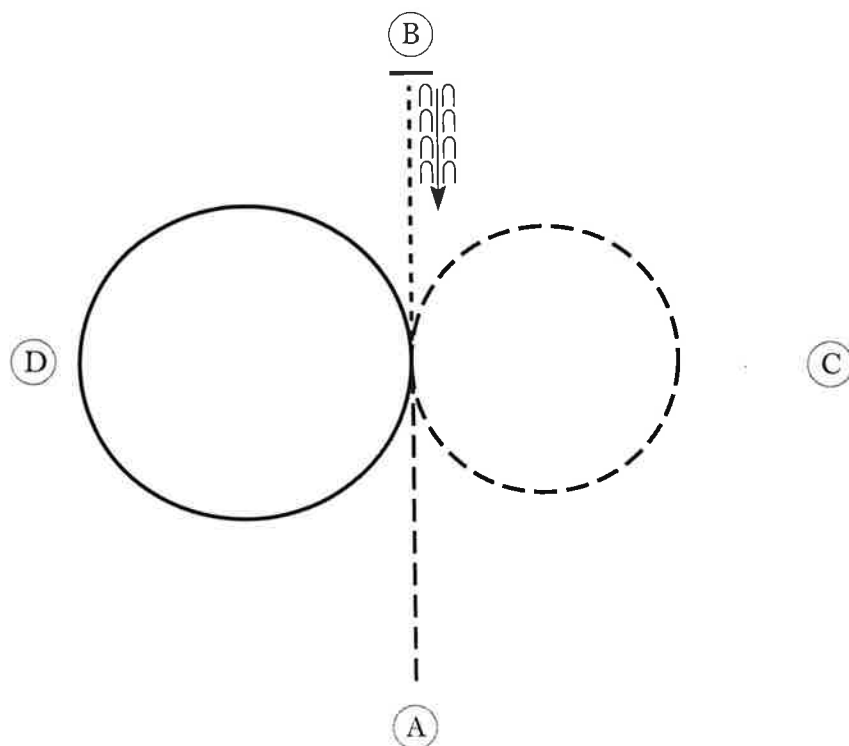

3. Canter a circle to the left.
4. Walk to B.
5. Stop in front of B and back approximately one horse length.

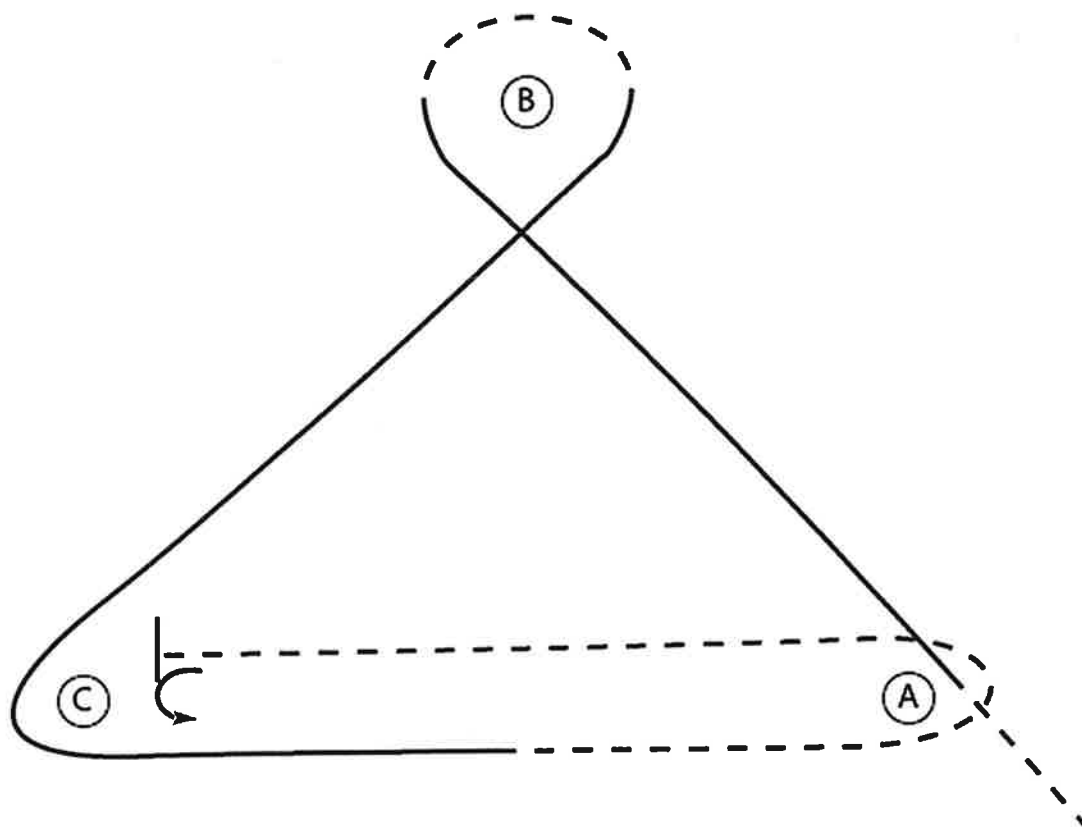

3. At B canter on the left lead to and around C and continue towards A
4. Halfway to A posting trot on the right diagonal to and around A and continue towards C
5. Halfway to C sit the trot
6. Stop at C
7. Perform a 90 degree forehand turn to the left.

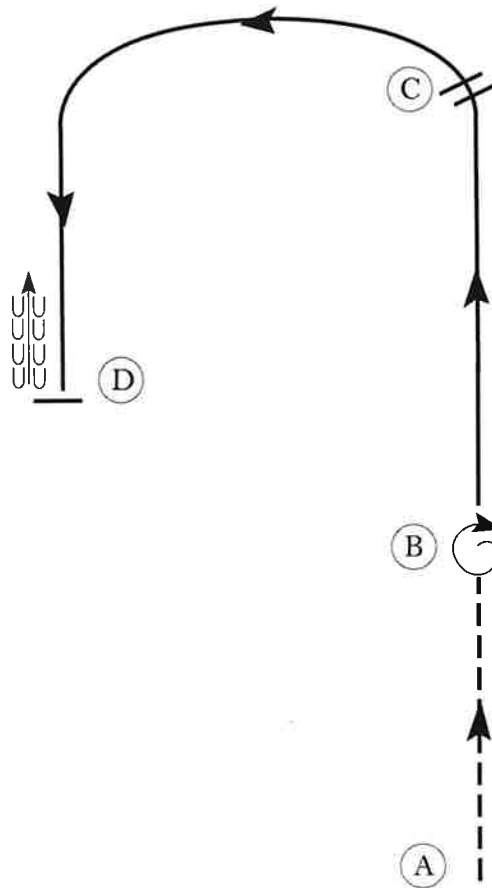

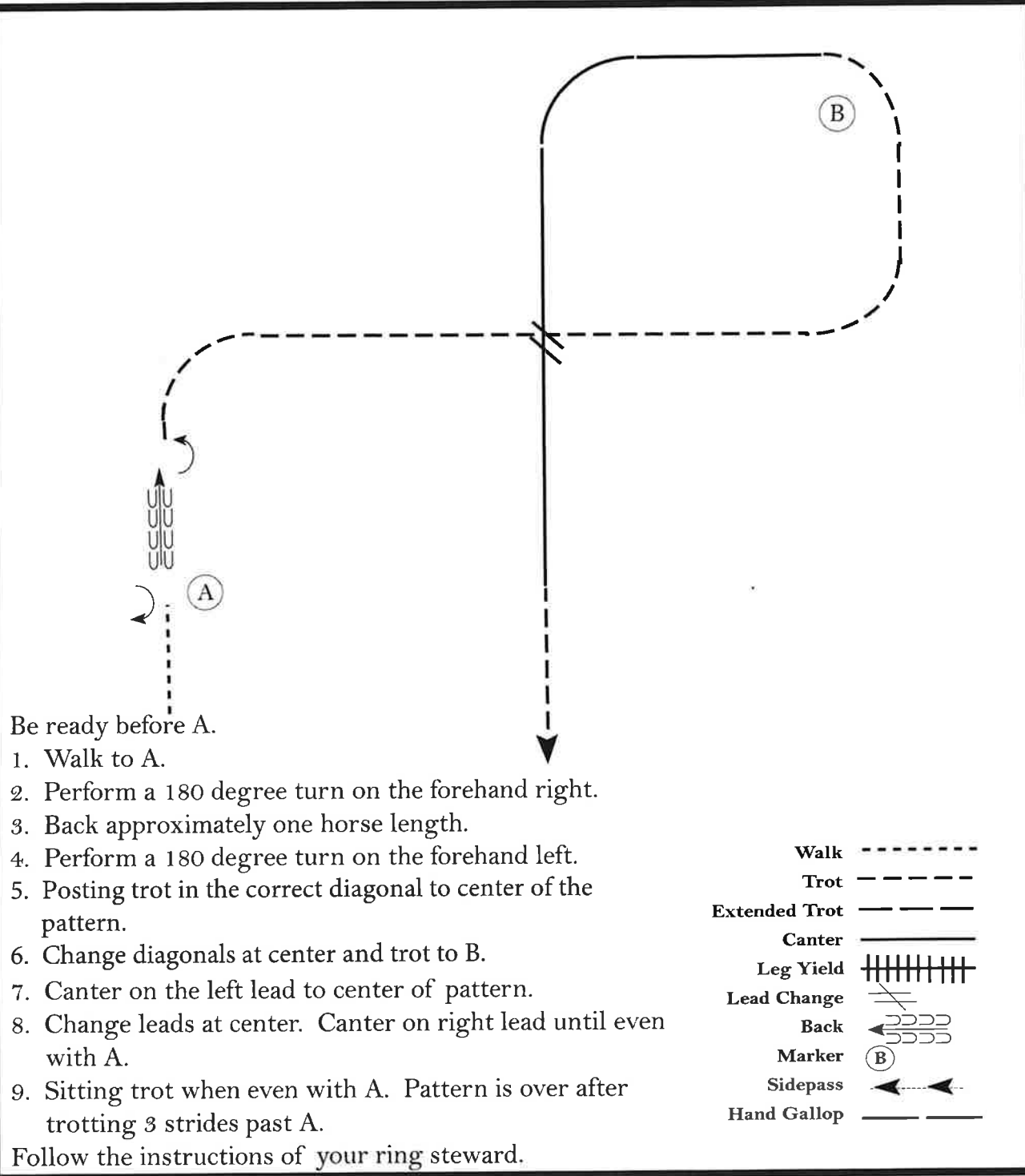

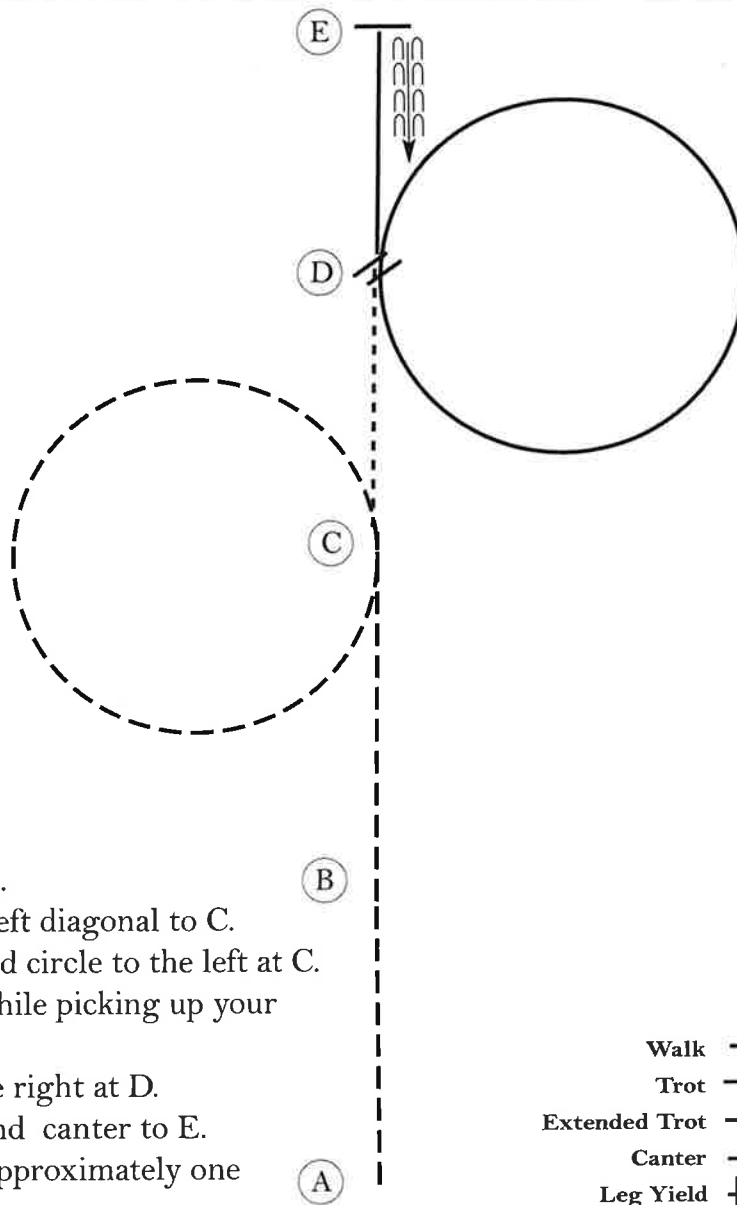

Be ready at A.

3. Posting trot on the left diagonal to C.
4. Change diagonals and circle to the left at C.
5. Walk from C to D while picking up your irons.
6. Canter a circle to the right at D.
7. Change leads at D and canter to E.
8. Stop at E and back approximately one horse length.

Exit at a trot.

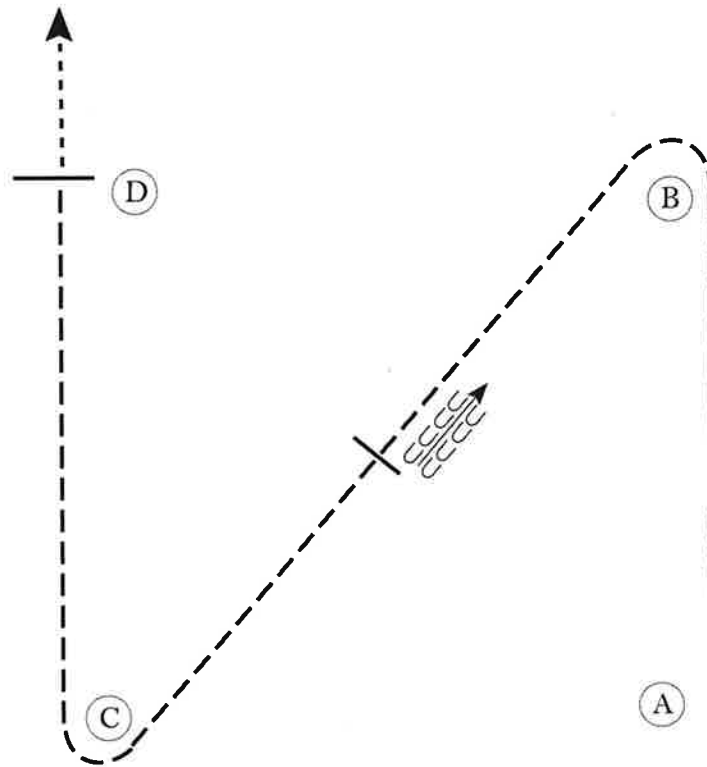

Be ready at A.

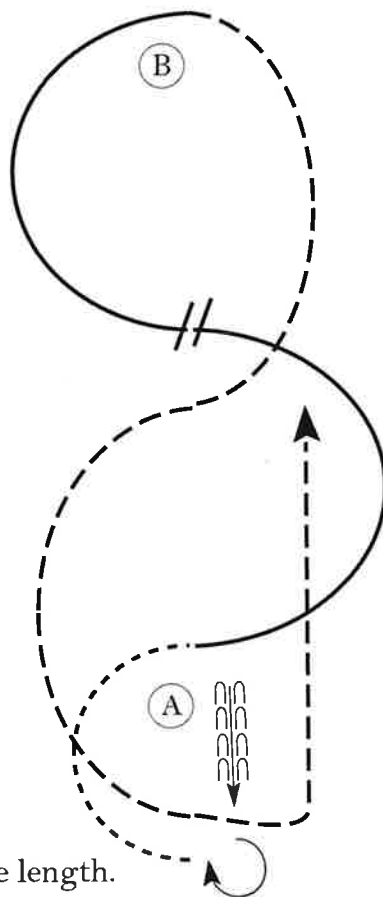
1. Walk approximately two horse lengths from A.
2. Trot to B.
3. At B, trot around B to middle.
4. Stop at middle and back one horse length.
5. Trot to C.
6. At C, trot around C to D.
7. Stop at D.
8. Exit at a walk.

Be ready at A.

1. Back approximately one horse length.
2. Perform a 3/4 turn on the forehand right.
3. Walk around A.
4. Canter on the left lead in a half circle.
5. Change leads and canter on the right lead to B.
6. Break to a posting trot and trot a serpentine to A showing a change of diagonals in center.
7. At A, sitting trot around corner toward B.

Pattern is over once you have trotted past the center point of the pattern.

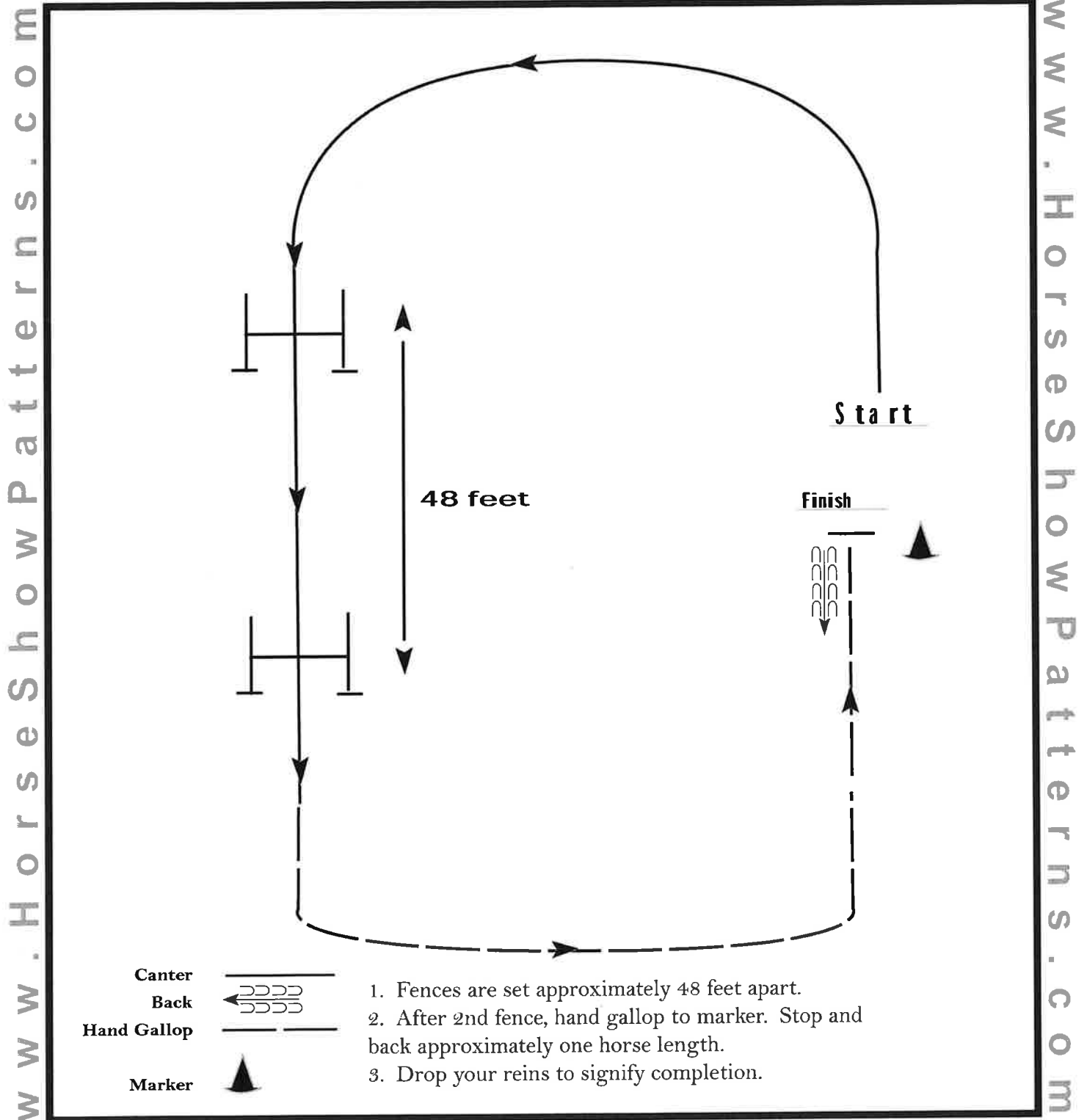
