4 County Marias Fair Archery Tournament

There will not be a physical 4 county Marias Fair Archery tournament. Each county will host their own tournament. The good news is that there will be no entry fees and Archery members will have a chance for a little more practice since there was a late start. The format should be similar to the normal Marias Fair tournament with 2 practice ends and then start the 10 ends that are scored with the time limit of 2 minutes 30 seconds per end. All counties' scores must be turned in by March 9th. More information will be coming as we settle on a specific date for the shoot here in Liberty County. It will most likely be in late February, or very early March.

4 County Marias Fair Air Rifle/Pistol Tournament

The Marias Fair Air Rifle/Pistol tournament will also be hosted by individual counties. There will be no fee to register for the tournament and it will also be taking place in late February to very early March.
