Call for help

Do you think county government in Big Horn County should be more representative of the people? Here's your chance to put your time where your mouth is.

Dave Seder, the chair of the Big Horn County Government Study Commission, has been trying to generate interest in the establishment of "community councils."

There would be three community councils, each consisting of three volunteers who would bring the concerns of their districts to their respective county commissioner.

Under Montana law, the study commission has the right to recommend this change to the county commissioners, who then could pass resolution and make the councils a reality.

Seder and others who have been involved in the government study think it's a good idea. "We're mainly looking for people willing to serve," he said.

The study commission does not want to waste the commissioners' time by having them establish councils upon which no one will serve.

Seder is asking people who would be willing to serve on these councils to either call the county commissioners at 665-3720 or Ellen Lundberg, who serves as the study commission secretary, at 665-1507.
