If some change is deemed necessary, the study commission may submit such proposed change to the electors.

In the conduct of their review the study commission has studied various forms and plans of city government. All meetings of the study commission were open to the public. Public hearings were held to determine citizen opinion.

After due deliberation and as a result of discussions held and the public hearings the City of Ronan Local Government Study Commission has concluded that there is a general consensus that the existing form and plan of government remain the same with no alterations or change.
