As ratified by the voters on November 2, 1976, HELENA the government of the Town of Eureka shall be organized under the following provisions of Section 47A-3-203: Revised Codes of Montana, 1947.

Commission-Executive Form, Sections 1-4a, inclusive.

In summary, this form allows for five elected persons who handle the town's business, meeting once a monthin regular meetings. This form is the most widely used in the United States, and in Montana 123 towns and cities have functioned under this form.
