Rexford review panel organizes, sets meeting dates

The Rexford Government Review Board met for an organizational session Monday, establishing a schedule for meetings and electing officers.

The 3-member board elected Leo O'Brien as chairman and decided to meet the first Monday of every other month. Those meetings will be begin March 6 at 7 p.m. in the Rexford Community Hall.

O Brien appointed Richard Payton as assistant chairman and Kim Van Bimmel as secretary.

The review board will consider three options for the town's government: town meetings, disincorporation, and modifying the current form of government, which has a commission and the mayor as the executive.

Included on the March 6 agenda will be review of the board's budget and discussion of a survey of Rexford residents on town government, Van Bimmel said.
