REXFORD STUDY COMMISSION

Consensus of the Rexford Study Commission came from the first public meeting. The Study Commission presented several options to the public. Attendees from the community stated they were not dissatisfied with the type of government. The problem was not enough people were interested in filling the council positions in the two wards. The public felt only one ward was needed with the council persons selected from the town at large.

The Study Commission is recommending: 1) Three council members at large and a mayor; 2) The term shall be four years; and 3) the council members and mayor complete the terms as voted by the public. (Two council persons at one election (1995) and one council person and mayor in another election (1997). Positions to continue on a staggered basis.

The current type of government is a mayor at large and four council persons (two from two wards) and all on four year terms.
