Attention Applicators and Distributors: Final Cancellation of Rozol Prairie Dog Bait. Cecil Tharp, MSU Pesticide Education Specialist, Bozeman, MT

EPA has announced the cancellation of Rozol Prairie Dog Bait in Montana, New Mexico, North Dakota and South Dakota on August 8th, 2011. This was in accordance with the court order issued on July 27th, 2011, and an approved application form from Liphatech to amend the label to remove Montana, New Mexico, North Dakota and South Dakota from the list of states where this product is authorized under FIFRA. Stocks of Rozol Prairie Dog Bait are restricted from use in Montana. The provisions of this cancellation are as follows:

- > The registrant must re-label any existing stocks within its possession and control to reflect the new label restrictions.
- No person may sell or distribute existing stocks unless, for each such transfer, a copy of the final cancellation order accompanies that transaction.
- No person may sell or distribute existing stocks in Montana, New Mexico, North Dakota, and South Dakota unless such sale or distribution is for the purpose of disposal, returning the material to the person or entity from whom it was purchased, or for transfer for the purpose of resale outside of Montana, New Mexico, North Dakota and South Dakota.

Pesticide distributors who have Rozol Prairie Dog Bait should contact Liphatech to arrange return and potential refunds. The product registrant (Liphatech) can relabel returned products for resale in other states.
