Private applicators in Judith Basin, Fergus, Petroleum, Wheatland, Golden Valley, Musselshell, Sweet Grass, Stillwater, Yellowstone, Carbon and Big Horn counties should be sure they have attained 6 credits prior to the January 1st, 2013 deadline to avoid losing their pesticide license.
