EPA Announcing Changes to the 1992 Agricultural Worker Protection Standards Cecil Tharp, MSU Pesticide Education

EPA is announcing stronger protections for two million agricultural workers and their families working on farms, forests, nurseries, and greenhouses. This is a revision to the 1992 Agricultural Worker Protection Standard. Farmers and states will be given time to adjust to these new requirements. Most of the revisions will be effective approximately 14 months after the rule publishes in the Federal Register. EPA will announce an official date once the rule publishes in the federal register.
