




## 2016 Train the Trainer Update for Pesticide Educators.

The Montana State University Pesticide Education Program is offering a pesticide education train the trainer opportunity April 21<sup>st</sup> and 22<sup>nd</sup> at the Holiday Inn (5 East Baxter Lane), Bozeman, MT. Attendees of this program can attain 5 commercial / government recertification credits in the categories of dealer, ag plant pest, ornamental & turf, right-of-way, forest pest, seed treatment, demonstration and research, and regulatory weed pest.

This training includes a large section dedicated to pesticide mode of action and tank mixing. Speakers will discuss important mode of action classes while relating to safety, environmental and/or management implications. Assisting with this are:

- Dr. Kevin Wanner, MSU Extension Crop Entomologist, covering insecticide mode of action
- Stephen Vantassel, MDA Vertebrate Pest Specialist, covering rodenticide mode of action
- Dr. Mary Burrows, MSU Extension Plant Pathologist, covering fungicide mode of action
- Dr. Fabian Menalled, MSU Crop Weeds Specialist, covering herbicide mode of action
- Mat Walter, MSU Extension Musselshell Agent, covering tank mixing

Other speakers include Dr. Cecil Tharp (MSU Pesticide Education Specialist) teaching 'Tips on Teaching Calibration to Farm Applicators' as well as a session titled 'Using Technologies when Calibrating Sprayers'; and Patrick Hensleigh (USDA-NRCS Agronomist) teaching educators on using the NRCS WIN-PST pesticide movement tool.
