## Addendums

Fairbook updates that were not in printed 2021-22 Fairbook

### **Shooting Sports Dress Code:**

Arm guards are required, and long hair must be tied back behind the ears.

### **Shirts:**

4-H collared shirts or t-shirts are acceptable.

Snap, button or pullover collared shirt or t-shirts or polos without graphics.

For safety reasons, tank tops, and shirts showing the midriff area, are not allowable while participating in 4-H shooting sport activities.

### **Pants:**

Jeans, without holes or slacks.

### **Shoes/Footwear:**

Casual shoes, tennis shoes, or boots. For safety reasons, shoes must cover the entire foot and must be closed toe.

### **Air rifle:**

Normal low-cut, street-type or athletic shoes, including toe shoes, must be worn in all positions. Shoes may not extend above the mid-point of the ankle and must have a flexible sole.

Shooting jackets and special shooting pants are not permitted. Special shooting sweaters, shirts, or jackets with additional or special pads are not permitted.

Heifer Futurity: Animals are permitted to go home, rather than stay at fairgrounds for duration of fair.

Food Items are permitted in live and silent auction, with the understanding that a fresh item will be made for the auction winner.

# Interviews

**IMPORTANT:** Welding, Woodworking, and all Foods interviews will be held at the pavilion. All other interviews will be at the middle school. Interviews start at 1:00PM Monday July 11th.

Please look over the enclosed interview schedule carefully. If we have left your name off a project, or if you have a conflict, please notify the Extension Office at 322- 8035 immediately, we will do our best to make accommodations but we can not guarantee you a specific time slot.

This year we will again be using one rubric for the interviews, but ask that members use their record books in their interview as a reference to their project(s). Your record books will be checked by your club leader as usual.

## Prepare for Your Interview!

1. Everyone will Check in at the middle school registration desk at least 15 minutes before your interview (even if your first interview is foods, woodworking, or welding, which will be held at the pavilion).

\* Let us know if you were unable to bring an exhibit.

\* Pick up your packet with your stall cards, entry tags, and back number.

2. Stall Cards must be complete, and entry tags attached to the correct exhibit.

3. Remain outside the interview area until the judge is ready.

4. Be on time for your interview, and bring your exhibits and records. Interview questions will evaluate project involvement (knowledge of project, interest, ability, attitude, and additional work).

NO premiums will be paid on unrecorded ribbons.

Judges are experts: their decisions are final. Remember that each decision is one person's opinion and it is inevitable that s/he can't please everyone. Please keep this in mind and put yourself in the judge's place. Common courtesy and a thank-you are necessary.

## Interview Tips

**The best advice for an interview is to relax and enjoy the experience. Remember, you know more about your project or 4H career than anyone else. Judges are looking for how comfortable you are with your project and knowledge of the subject matter. Never underestimate the power of a smile - judges are looking for the confidence that says you are enjoying the experience of presenting your project and yourself.**

- Arrive on Time
- Shake hands firmly, if offered
- Think about the question before immediately answering
- Be enthusiastic & honest
- Sell yourself—make the interviewer remember you
- Explain achievements or good characteristics in story form
- Give specific answers
- Have intelligent questions memorized to ask at the end of the interview
- Practice, practice, practice

**You've got this!**

- o You can take your projects to the pavilion before your interview to eliminate hauling your projects everywhere.
- o We will announce when interview judges are ready and the first person on the interview list will head to their respective room.
- o We will have 2 people waiting outside each interview area; otherwise wait in the commons for your interview time.
- o If you are not interviewing, or "on deck" or "in the hole"; please stay in the commons area of the middle school, the hallways get very noisy and crowded if too many people are in the hallway.
- o There is a map of where each interview will take place, and signs to direct you at the school.
- If you have questions, please let us know.


