

Nanna Flesch Memorial Scholarship

INTRODUCTION: The Canyon Creek Stock 4-H Club in Lewis and Clark County, Montana donated \$1000 to start this scholarship to remember Nanna Flesch. More of the funds were provided through donations from a meal provided by Robyn Kimmet and TLC Catering. Nanna Flesch was a 4-H mom and caring leader for many years. She was involved in 4-H many years with her sheep and beef projects and continued her love of 4-H through her children and their beef and swine projects.

Who: The award will only be given to a Toole County 4-H Member in the following livestock projects: steer, swine, goat, and sheep. The Toole County 4-H Council will determine the number of deserving applicants that year, and preference will be given to members new to the livestock project. The scholarship will only be available for the recipient once.

What: \$1000 for a steer, \$300 pig, \$300 lamb, or \$200 goat project

How it works:

- Fill out the application and submit it to the Toole County Extension Office by **October 26th, 2022**
- The recipients, after a vetting process, will receive the cash prize scholarship. Recipients will be announced at the 4-H Achievement Day.
- Applicants may be interviewed

As a recipient:

- Raising an animal is a big commitment, but we have many people willing to help!
- Toole County 4-H Council will provide the sponsorship up front so you can purchase an animal and buy feed or supplies.
- Raising animals comes with costs and risks. Costs associated with raising an animal from feed, supplies, vaccinations, healthcare, or vet services are the responsibility of the animal owner. The recipient must be prepared to pay the further costs required after receiving the scholarship.

- The recipient is required to provide a detailed accounting of how their scholarship money was spent. This accounting will be turned in with the recipient's record books at the end of the 4-H year.

Recipients will be selected by members of the Toole County 4-H Council. No family member(s) of an applicant will be on the selection committee.

As per Toole County 4-H rules, if I do not complete the record book with all the scholarship information, I understand that I will not be able to participate in next years events or livestock sale.
