SHOWCASE-APRIL 13, 2024-QUILT SHOW REGISTRATION

Yellowstone County 4-H will be having its 28th Annual Quilt Show at 4-H Showcase to be held April 13, 2024. Any 4-H member or relative of a 4-H member is invited to participate.

Quilt Show Rules

- 1. Fill out the form below and return it to the Extension Office by 5:00 pm March 29, 2024 (not postmarked by).
- 2. Bring your quilt to Showcase check-in 8:00 to 8:30 on April 13. DO NOT bring quilts to the office!
- 3. **Quilts must be labeled with the following information**: Quilt maker's name, age, years in project, address, phone number, category entered, club, and the 4-H member you are related to if entering in the adult class.
- 4. Quilts must be entered in the name of the maker if different than the owner.
- 5. Quilts that have competed in past Showcase shows may not be entered again in this show.
- 6. 4-H members may enter 2 quilted items and adults may enter one quilted item.
- 7. Item must be quilted not just a sewn project.
- 8. Quilts will be judged and hung for public viewing at the Showcase. 4-H Quilt makers (not adults) must be present at the Showcase to enter the quilt show for an interview. Quilts can be taken home after the show.
- 9. Senior qualifying quilts or wall hangings will be eligible to compete in the quilt show at the 4-H State Congress. (Contact the Extension office for rules regarding the state Congress quilt show.)
- 10. 4-H members may have help with their quilts, but they must list all areas of the quilt making process in which they had help with.
- 11. Quilts may be moved to another quilt category if not entered in the correct category.
