- _____ 6. The club had all 4-H enrollments (both leader & member) completed by Jan. 1.
- _____ 7. A written yearly program was submitted to the County Extension Office by Jan. 1.
- _____ 8. The average attendance at regular meeting was at least 80%.
- _____ 9. All meeting minutes were sent to the County Extension Office within one week after each meeting.
- _____ 10. The club reporter reported each meeting and club events to the local newspapers. The clippings were placed in the secretary's book or club scrapbook.
- _____ 11. Every member appeared on the club program or gave a report at least twice in the year.
- _____ 12. The club had an organized club activity (i.e., health, conservation, recreation, marketing, or safety)
- _____ 13. The club had at least two club events during the year (i.e., tour, picnic, achievement day, community program, etc.)
- _____ 14. The club had a planned community service program.
- _____ 15. The club had recreation at 80% of their meetings.
- _____ 16. At least two people, other than members, local leaders & County Extension Agents were used on the program during the year.
- _____ 17. Each member's parents attended at least two meetings or club events.
- _____ 18. At least 90% of the members completed records by the date due (Oct. 1).
- _____ 19. Every member gave a demonstration, speech, or other presentation.
- _____ 20. The club had at least three participants in County Communication Day.
- _____ 21. The club planned a fun activity outside of their regularly scheduled business meeting.
- _____ 22. The club had members participating in county judging events in which the members were eligible.
- _____ 23. The club prepared a window display or did some other activity for National 4-H Week.
- _____ 24. At least 80% of the members exhibited at a public event.
- _____ 25. At least 50% of the members participated in one or more county events.
- _____ 26. The club was represented at 80% of county 4-H Council and leader training meetings (includes project leader training).
- _____ 27. The club was host to another 4-H or other youth group during the year.
- _____ 28. Club members participated in regional, state, or international opportunities.
- _____ 29. At least 50% of members took new projects.
- _____ 30. The club audit was completed and turned into the Extension Office.
