**Call to Order:** Meeting was called to order at 6:49 pm by President Brenda Ryder.

**Minutes:** Minutes from December 2 meeting were read. Skelly Adkins moved to accept the minutes as corrected, Ann Marie Mills-Low seconded, motion passed.

**Treasurer's report:** Caroline Brito reported \$97,777.03 in account as of 1/31/22. Justin Whitmus moved to accept report Valory Seely seconded, motion passed.
