

Yellowstone County Council Minutes May 4, 2023

Call to Order: Meeting was called to order at 6:32 pm by President Kayla Koivu

Pledges: Presented by Lucas Arkell and May Russel.

Minutes: Minutes from April 6, 2023 meeting were read. Motion to accept minutes made by Heather Arkell, seconded by Cathy Muessig, motion passed.

Treasurer's report: Caroline Brito reported \$112,810.02 in account as of 4/30/2023. Discussion as to question about variances in ending/starting balances from the prior meeting was discussed. Stephanie Johnson moved that we use the ending bank balance on the monthly statement and that we accept the Treasures report, Angie Murdick seconded, motion passed.

County BB Gun Team going to National Shoot (Arkansas July 6-9, 2023 Matt Russell/Kevin Adkins leaders and May Russell, Lukas Arkell, Carson Adkins and Rex Koivu. members approached Council regarding funding for the upcoming trip. There will be 7 kids and 2 chaperones going, last year cost was \$16,000. Reported on scores from State Shoot and that 3 MT teams are going, Yellowstone, Carbon and Gallatin. Stephanie Johnson moved to give \$500 per kid and chaperone, Jordyn Trupka seconded, motion passed.
