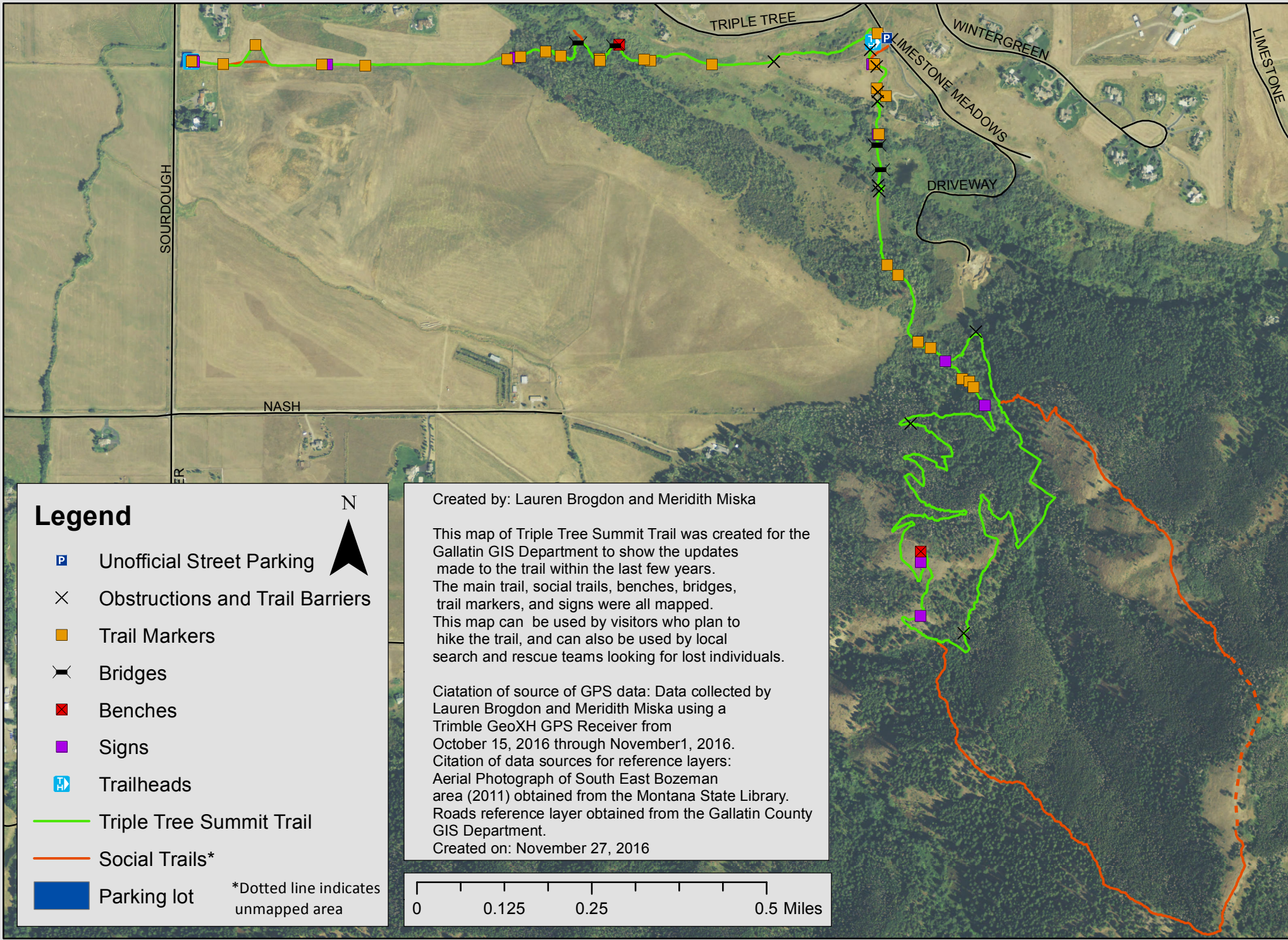












Triple Tree Summit Trail
