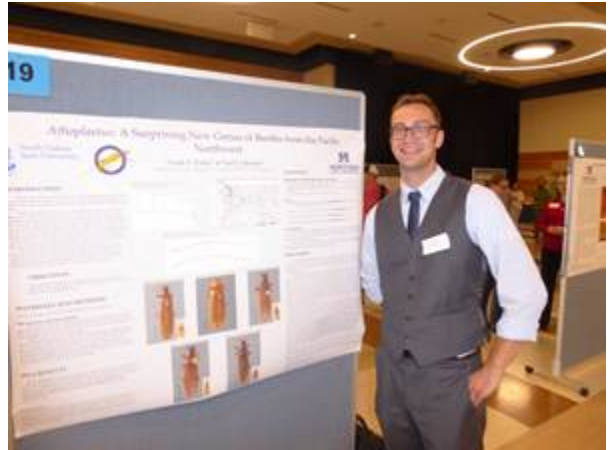
I am Shriyansh Kothari a master's student in Computer Science. I am the graduate assistant for The Graduate School and am also excited to be part of the graduate student community.
