Play an active role in matters pertaining to graduate education at Montana State University

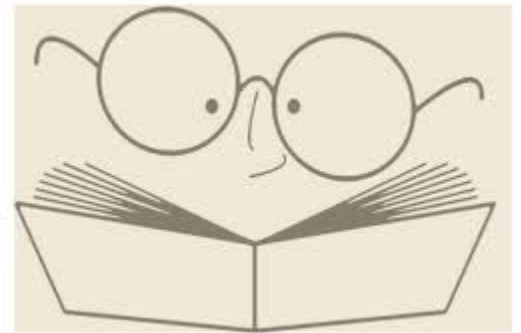
