April 17, 2018: Last day for approval of thesis, dissertation, or professional paper (if professional paper is submitted to the library) by formatting advisor.

May 4, 2018: Last day to withdraw spring graduation application; last day to file a summer one-credit extension graduation application.

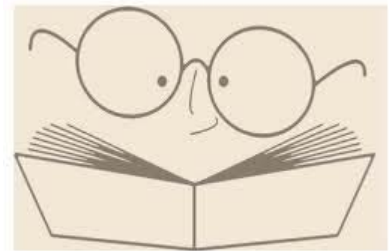
Professional Development Activities for Graduate Students
