The place **to apply**

Undergraduate

1. Submit the international undergraduate application and \$38 application fee:
www.msuadmissions.com/international
2. Send your transcripts to MSU. Unofficial emailed copies are accepted for admissions purposes. If admitted, you will need to provide an official transcript.

Freshman requirements: Minimum of 2.5 GPA on a 4.0 scale.

Transfer requirements: Minimum of 2.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale. Please send transcripts from all institutions attended. Final official transcripts are needed for transfer credit evaluation.

3. Provide proof of English proficiency by one of the following:
 - TOEFL iBT 71
 - TOEFL PBT 525
 - IELTS 6.0
 - PTE Academic: 48
 - English3: 58
 - SAT Reading/Writing: 650
 - ACT English: 20
 - iTEP: 3.7
 - An associate's degree from a U.S. community college
 - Completion of an approved intensive English program

Conditional admission

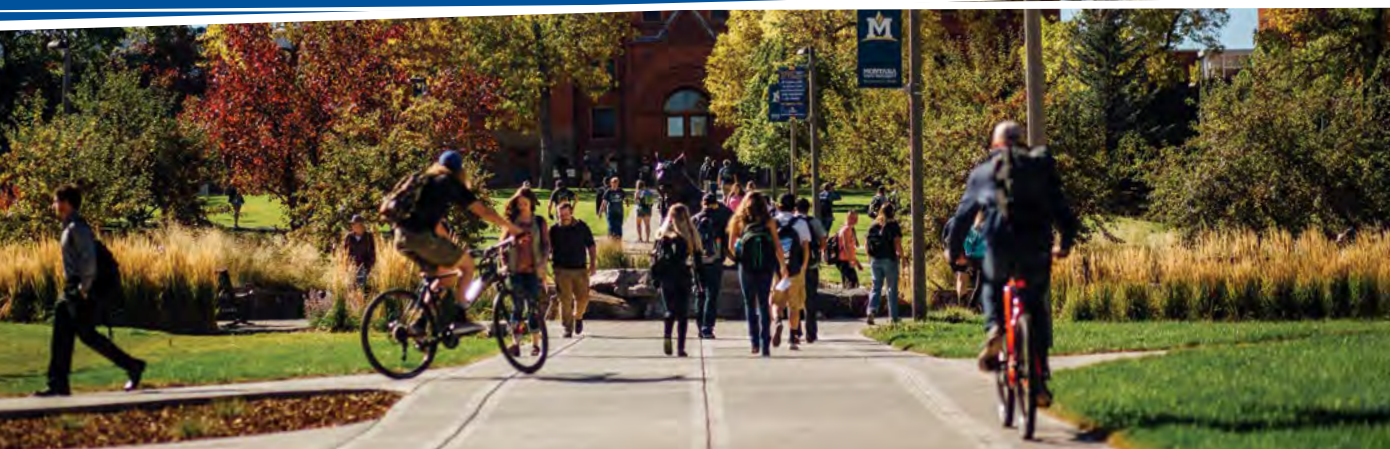
MSU offers conditional admission to undergraduate applicants who meet all admissions requirements except for proof of English proficiency. Conditional admission will place you in MSU's intensive English program with INTERLINK Language Center.

Graduate

Graduate admissions at MSU are decentralized, which means that each program has its own unique admissions requirements. Please review your program's website to learn how to apply.

Most departments require the following:

- Submission of online graduate application and \$60 application fee: www.montana.edu/gradschool/admissions/apply
- Minimum 3.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale
- Transcripts for all post-secondary coursework complete
- Three letters of recommendation
- Statement of purpose
- GRE or GMAT
- Resume/CV
- Proof of English proficiency:
 - TOEFL iBT 80
 - TOEFL PBT 550
 - IELTS 6.5
 - PTE Academic 54
 - Completion of a post-secondary degree from an institution in the U.S. or other country where English is the native and official language
