Montana State University- Bozeman Nordic skier Noah Andersen has been named to the 2016-2017 Academic All-District VII Men's At-Large First-Team, the College Sports Information Directors of America Announced May 12th.

His name will now appear on the national ballot for Academic All-American consideration, the nation's top academic honor for college athletes.

The junior from Bozeman helped guide the Bobcats to a sixth –place finish at the 2017 NCAA Skiing Championships. He took 29<sup>th</sup> in the 20K freestyle and 38<sup>th</sup> in the 10K classic at the NCAA Championships. On the RMISA circuit, Andersen finished 26<sup>th</sup> in Qualifying Points, which Included a Season-best 12<sup>th</sup> in Classic at the MSU Invitational. At the RISA/NCAA West Regional championships, Andersen too 16<sup>th</sup> in the 10K classic. He is also a three-time USCSCA National Collegiate All-Academic Ski Team honoree.

To qualify for academic All-District honors, a student athlete must have a 3.20 or higher cumulative grade-point average, be of sophomore academic standing and have made a contribution during the 2016-2017 season. Andersen has a 3.96 cumulative GPA in Mechanical Engineering.
