III. Approval of Meeting Minutes

IV. Public Comment

- a. Board of Regents (BOR) meeting earlier this morning BOR requested clarification around who has authority over the university system, in light of House Bill 102 regarding the right to carry arms on campus.
- b. Return to office directive Please provide Whitney and Julie with feedback so they can more fully represent staff at their meeting with President Cruzado and Terry Leist at the end of the month.

V. Informational Item

a. Chosen Name

Eric Wold and Julie Clay, University Information Technology

- A chosen name is a sincerely held name, not a legal name, used on campus
- Names can make people feel more welcome, respected, safe
- Wide variety of reasons people prefer not to use their legal name
- Pilot program with 41 participants, will be available to all students and MSU employees later this year
- 4-campus project, engaged key stakeholders, collaborated with Human Resources and Registrar to design procedures
- Goal is to make this a formal, standardized, comprehensive service
- The chosen name is displayed on the email address, Catcard, and integrated systems
- The chosen name is recorded in Banner, but Banner uses the legal name
- Chosen name is for institutionally focused interactions



- Discretion is important, sensitive topic chosen name and legal name should not be displayed together
- Legal name must still be used for federal government information, state of Montana information, insurance provider, retirement, financial aid/federal loans, taxes, payroll, and financial institutions
- Program will open October 21 for Bozeman and Great Falls, other campuses will choose their own rollout date
- To change Banner user ID, name must already be changed on social security card, then submit request to Human Resources start with Ann Robinson

VI. Previous Business

- a. Proposed Operating Agreement Amendments Governance Committee
 - Remove the position of Past Chair
 - Member-at-Large will take over Pure Gold reviewer responsibilities
 - DEI Chair will take on the Diversity & Inclusion Council responsibilities
 - Make all internal committee chairs voting members of the executive team
 - Include verbiage to allow members to switch committees during the annual election process, for flexibility to meet interests and utilize passions and skill sets
 - Lasso motioned to approve the amendments to the Operating Agreement, Weitz seconded, no further discussion, motion passed unanimously with no abstentions
- b. Proposed Addendum A Amendments Governance Committee
 - Added option to renew term for either one or two years
 - Remove the specific number of committees so we won't have to change the
 Addendum if a committee is added or removed
 - Added DEI Committee
 - Added Pure Gold reviewer
 - Added Program Coordinator responsibilities
 - Anderson motioned to accept all changes to Addendum A as proposed, Baciu seconded, no further discussion, motion passed unanimously with no abstentions
- c. Staff Scholarship Updates Scholarship subcommittee
 - 46 applicants, 20 scholarships awarded (\$250 \$600)
 - \$8,350 awarded total this year, leaving \$30 left in the account

 - 22 nominees, waiting to hear back regarding acceptance of nominations
 - Voting will take place May 24-28
- b. Staff Letter about recent House Bills Julie Clay
 - MSUASC members received an email from a staff member requesting participation in a lawsuit against the state of Montana regarding four house bills
 - MSU legal counsel we work for a public entity so cannot use university resources such as time or email to participate in lawsuit – staff may act individually on their own time, but not representing All Staff Council
 - Refer calls and questions to University Communications (Tracy Ellig)
 - University Communications provides training on what to say and what not to say
