The Montana Farm to School Institute is a year-long program intended to ignite, grow, and sustain farm to school action within Montana schools and communities by providing training and support, and facilitating team building and action planning.

Benefits + Commitment

- **Summer Retreat - August 16-18, 2022:** A three-day, in-person event at Chico Hot Springs in the Paradise Valley. Teams of 4-8 members will develop an action plan for the 2022-23 school year, network with farm to school experts and peers, and tour the robust Farm to School of Park County program.
- **Coaching Support:** Each team will be paired with a trained Farm to School Coach that will provide support and guidance in preparing for the Summer Retreat and implementing the school's farm to school action plan.
- **Continuing Education Credits:** The Institute will provide OPI Teacher Continuing Education Credits and School Nutrition Professional Credits.
