CRITERIA FOR APPLICATION

- A calculated GPA of 3.0 or higher in required prerequisite courses.
- All prerequisite courses must be completed with a grade of C- or better and no more than two of the required prerequisites can be repeated.
- At application, three of five of the natural science courses must be completed with a C- or better.
