TITLE: CHILDREN ATTENDING COLLEGE OF NURSING (CON) CLASSES

POLICY: Under normal circumstances, children will not be allowed to attend CON classes, labs, open

labs, simulation, or clinical experiences. The CON faculty realizes that on a rare occasion an emergency may arise which necessitates bringing a child to lecture. If the student has explored all options and must bring the child to lecture, the procedure below must be

followed.

RATIONALE: The CON wishes to be supportive to students with small children. However, optimal learning

conditions for all students must be considered and, as much as possible, maintained in the

classroom at all times.
