POLICY: The undergraduate student skills checklist allows a student to record and rate

their own skill performance.

RATIONALE: A thoughtful and comprehensive inventory of nursing skills:

a. assists in identifying and recording skills

- b. provides a communication mechanism for informing clinical preceptors (e.g. in NRSG 477, NRSG 487, NRSG 498) of previously demonstrated skills
- c. provides information to prospective employers and others seeking information about a student's learning experiences during the MSU nursing curriculum
- d. helps in development and implementation of MROs
- e. assists in evaluating courses
