POLICY C-14: PROCEDURE

TITLE: CORRELATION OF CLASSROOM AND CLINICAL EXPERIENCES

PROCEDURE: 1.

- 1. Clinical learning experiences are to be offered in an organized fashion throughout each course in order to meet the learning needs of the student and facilitate her/his attainment of course objectives.
- 2. A variety of methods may be utilized to provide for application of theoretical content to clinical practice.
- 3. A midterm evaluation in each clinical course is to be conducted with the student outlining formative assessment findings. A final summative clinical evaluation of each clinical course is to be conducted by the faculty member and presented to the student after theoretical content has been presented and learning experiences related to clinical application have been completed.
