Failure to acknowledge may subject the Bidder to disqualification and rejection of the bid. This Addendum forms part of the Contract Documents as if bound therein and modifies them as follows:

- II. AMENDMENTS TO THE PROJECT MANUAL

- III. AMENDMENTS TO THE DRAWINGS
 - A. Add to Key Note 8 on Sheet 3 the following sentence: "Electrical lines also run from the building to the waterers, the location of the electrical lines is unknown at this time."
- IV. GENERAL INFORMATION
 - A. City of Bozeman Building Department will issue an over the counter permit once a contractor is selected.
 The Contractor shall coordinate the application with the Engineer. No plan review fee is required.
 - B. City of Bozeman Building Department inspection will be required. Contractor to schedule inspections with the Building Department as needed. It is not known if Building Department will allow for multiple site inspections.
 - C. When Contractor calls in for utility locates the Owner needs to be included in order to allow for locator access to site.

Addition Pre-Bid Meeting Notes

- 1. Need electrician to disconnect electricity see Section 018001
- 2. Contractor to get locates. Owner to stake stub outs based on Morrison-Maierle information. Contractor needs to include client on locate ticket for locator access to site.
- 3. Dewatering discharge to south is best no surface water discharge
- 4. Reviewed special provisions
 - a. Access to site. 48-hour outage
 - b. Owner to move fence panels with notice
 - c. Work hours 7am 5 pm when owner is here. Can adjust if coordinated
- 5. Biosecurity to stay out of some areas
 - a. Don't touch animals
- 6. Hay operation and access to shed East of sitea. July for ± 3 weeks. Travel over trench from West
- 7. June 13 August 13: 3-week construction window
- 8. Trench through inside fenced areaa. Owner to remove fence as noted in the project documents
- Water and power to waterers and pump discharge to North

 Need to locate before digging
- 10. Sump pit ~ 4' X 8' deep +/
 - a. Pull pumps, cap outlet, fill with rock, reinstall cover
- 11. Concrete needs to be saw cut and replaced at sewer connection point
