## 1. INTRODUCTION AND PURPOSE

The faculty and university administration are responsible for assuring the highest ethical and professional standards and behavior in:

- **a.** working with undergraduate and graduate students, including the elimination of <u>discrimination</u> from the classroom and entire university community,
- b. working with faculty and staff,
- **c.** performing their contracted responsibilities, including the employment and use of graduate assistants or adjunct faculty and staff,
- d. working with public and private agencies, organizations, and businesses,
- e. preventing conflicts of interest and reporting work done outside the university,
- **f.** conducting peer review,
- g. conducting research and creative activity, (See, e.g. Research Misconduct Policy)
- **h.** adhering to standards for <u>biosafety</u>, research utilizing <u>human</u> and <u>animal</u> subjects, and the use of <u>radioactive</u> materials,
- **i.** respecting confidentiality and privacy in the use of information systems (see <u>Enterprise Information Technology Policies</u>),
- i. respecting copyright and patent requirements,

**k.** respecting confidentiality and privacy in personnel decisions, including search committee discussions,

**I.** participating in university planning and governance, and

**m.** reporting alleged breaches of ethical standards.

## 2. INVESTIGATION OF COMPLAINTS AND VIOLATIONS OF STANDARDS

Complaints of alleged breaches of these standards shall be investigated using the procedures set forth in the university's <u>Reporting Violations Policy</u> and the <u>Research Misconduct Policy</u> as general guidelines. The procedures may be adapted as necessary to consider a specific complaint.
