TO: Entities Attempting to Complete FFATA Reporting on Montana State University

I want to provide you with an explanation as well as supporting documentation of a situation I have discovered as it relates to the four digit (+4) extension to our zip code. As you may have discovered, Montana State University does not currently have the +4 added to our zip code in SAM, which in turn restricts your ability to report our institution for FFATA reporting purposes. When MSU's data was migrated over to SAM, it had the +4 zip code extension of 0000 which seemed to work in CCR, but in the migration this information was dropped to just the 59717.

In early May of 2013 this situation was brought to our attention by several institutions that were trying to complete the FFATA reporting and on May 13th I contacted Dun & Bradstreet to add the +4 to our zip code only to discover that this is turning into an impossible task. After 11 separate phone calls and/or emails over the past three weeks I am still unable to get this issue resolved. After a thorough investigation I believe that the issue involves the software that transmits data from D&B into the SAM registration and that I am unable to get this fixed. I have determined that D&B has our correct physical address for our DUNS # 625447982 (Congressional district #1) which should pull up our correct zip with the +4 zip as confirmed by the USPS, but unfortunately it does not. I have reported this to the Federal Service Desk and they say that they cannot make this change, so I believe I have exhausted all of the possible options to fix this and I am supplying this letter and documentation so that you can provide it to your auditors as proof that Montana State University has in good faith attempted to comply with FFATA reporting requirements. If you see a solution or step that I have missed please contact me.

Hi Leslie,

I have been on vacation which is why I have not picked up your voicemail.

D&B does not assign a +4, it is taken directly from the US Postal Service (based on the "physical" address). We collect the physical address of the company and when it is delivered to SAM it includes the +4 as issued by USPS.

According to USPS, this address is not recognized. As a result, no +4 is sent to SAM. Previously, when this situation occurred, registrants in CCR were asked to enter a +4 and, at one time, it looks like 0000 was entered. Now, SAM is trying to have a proper +4 added so that congressional district can be determined.

- Send an email via their site which will ultimately open a "ticket"
- In the subject line type: NEED zip+4 manually added to my registration
- Please be sure to provide them the +4 you are needing.
- Finally copy/paste into the email:
 "D&B states that the +4 Zip Code could not be processed on their side because USPS does not recognize the physical address"

Future communication will be between the awardee and the Federal Service Desk.
