

Bed Loft Instructions

Please be aware that furniture is new - any damage will be charged to the residents of the room. Please read carefully to prevent damage.



- Beds can be raised or lowered by adjusting the metal spring base.
- To raise the base, the hooks of the metal base must be placed into the end posts. *Note: that the metal base has 2 hooks on each end.*
- Each hook needs to be inserted over the steel rods in the metal channels embedded in the wooden posts.
- When changing the height or configuration, it is important that both hooks are disengaged on each end. If this does not happen, damage can occur.
- You can disengage the hook by placing a foot on a lower cross rail and lifting up on the metal base. Upward tapping under a corner might be needed to dislodge the hooks from the rods.
- By flipping the wooden end boards, different heights can be achieved.
