The City also has free drop-off sites at Walmart, Gallatin County Fairgrounds, Ballfields – Highland Blvd, MSU, Billion Auto, Safeway, and Bozeman Convenience Site. Get to know what you can and cannot recycle in the City of Bozeman!

What You <u>Can</u> Recycle:

- Plastics
 - #1 and #2 bottles and jugs
- Cans
 - Aluminum
 - Tin
 - Steel
- Cardboard
 - Flattened corrugated cardboard
 - Cereal and other paperboard boxes
- Paper
 - Newspaper, Magazines, and Catalogs
 - \circ $\,$ Writing and office paper $\,$
- Phone books
- Paper bags

Important! - Make Sure To...

- Rinse containers with water to eliminate food residue
- Clean, dry, and empty recyclables
- Flatten boxes to conserve space
- Keep garbage, food waste, and unclean items separate from recyclables
- Crush plastic bottles and put caps back on to conserve space (if feasible)
- (Labels do not need to be removed)

What You Cannot Recycle:

- Non-Bottle Shaped #1 and #2 Designated
 Plastics
- Any #3 through #7 Designated Plastics
- Glass or glassware
- Food contaminated pizza boxes, paper plates, napkins, etc
- Aerosol cans
- Pill bottles
- Ceramics
- Foil
- Metal hangers
- Batteries
- Light bulbs
- Juice boxes and pouches
- Chip bags
- Styrofoam containers and packing peanuts
- Paper milk cartons
- Plastic bags
- Frozen food bags
- Toxic Product Containers (oil bottles, antifreeze containers, herbicide containers, pesticide containers, etc)
